

TARPORLEY COMMUNITY CENTRE AND RECREATION GROUND CIO (“TCC”) ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

The TCC will consider the effects on the environment of the actions it proposes to take and will encourage users of its facilities to do the same.

In particular TCC will

a) endeavour to use the minimum amount of energy consistent with the safe and efficient operation of its facilities. It will from time to time review its energy sources, energy using appliances and energy usage and discuss with staff and hirers how energy use might be reduced,

b) endeavour to minimise and where possible eliminate all forms of pollution. Users of TCC facilities will be reminded of the need to reduce excessive noise particularly late in the evening,

c) use the minimum amount of water consistent with its needs and those of the users. It will periodically check for leaks and eliminate excessive or unnecessary use particularly when the facilities are not in use,

d) minimise waste and ensure any waste is disposed of neatly in the bins provided by the local authority,

e) ensure that the potential environmental impact of any building projects is assessed and minimised. This will include methods of construction, designs which results in low maintenance and high energy efficiency and the use of materials from sustainable sources, eg timber, favouring local sources to minimise transport costs and thus reduce polluting the air.

f) as appropriate draw the attention of all TCC users of its facilities to this Policy and encourage them to ally themselves to its provisions.
