Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

Mandatory Condition: Exhibition of Films

1. The admission of children to a film exhibition shall be restricted in accordance with Section 20 of the Licensing Act 2003.
2. The film classification body for the purposes of this licence shall be the British Board of Film Classification.
3. Where any such film has not been classified by the film classification body then the Licensing Authority will expect the Premises Licence Holder to submit the film to the Authority at least 28 days before it intends to show it. The Authority will then conduct an assessment of the suitability of the film for exhibition to children and classify the film accordingly so that the Premises Licence Holder can implement appropriate measures to restrict viewing by children if necessary.
4. No film exhibition shall be shown at the premises unless it has been classified by the British Board of Film Classification or assessed by the Licensing Authority and only the following classifications shall be applied:-
 - U - Universal. Suitable for audiences aged four years and over.
 - PG - Parental Guidance. Some scenes may be unsuitable for young children.
 - 12A - Passed only for viewing by persons aged 12 years or older or persons younger than 12 when accompanied by an adult.
 - 15 - Passed only for viewing by persons aged 15 years and over.
 - 18 - Passed only for viewing by persons aged 18 years and over.
5. Where a programme includes a film classified by the British Board of Film Classification or considered by the Licensing Authority to fall into the 12A, 15 or 18 category, no person appearing to be under the age of 12 and unaccompanied by an adult or under 15 or 18 as appropriate shall be admitted to any part of the programme.
